Osseo Area Learning Center serves students in grades 9-12 and offers an alternative high school program for students in ISD 279-Osseo Area Schools. Enrollment is by application. OALC is open to resident and non-resident students, and transportation is available for eligible students.



**OPPORTUNITY**

Traditional, online, blended learning and project-based courses; credit recovery; career/work experience and student leadership opportunities.



**SUPPORT**

Clothing closet; food pantry; and on-site social worker, skills for success course, small class sizes.

**INDIVIDUAL ATTENTION**

Most OALC students thrive in a smaller school environment with more individual attention. As standards are mastered, .25 credits are awarded every 3 weeks.

On-site licensed child care and child development classes help students build parenting skills and stay on track to graduate.
